During this annual reporting period, the Organization started the year with 6 dogs in foster care and during the year rescued a total of 31 more Shelties. 26 of these Shelties were placed with adopters, 1 transferred to other rescue agencies and 4 died in foster care. 6 dogs were in foster care at the end of 2017. These numbers were reported to the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, as required annually.
